## PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

Due to the replacement of a 6" valve serving this location, there will be a temporary loss in pressure on March 18, 2025, at approximately 8:00 am. Water service is expected to be restored by 4:00pm. If you are at this location, you may experience discolored water for approximately 24 hours after your water service has been restored.

As a precaution, we advise that all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, or washing dishes be boiled. A rolling boil for one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

This "Precautionary Boil Water Notice" will remain in effect until the water line repair is completed and a bacteriological survey shows that the water is safe to drink. The City will issue a rescission lifting this "Precautionary Boil Water Notice" at that time and you will be notified by a handout notice at your address.
